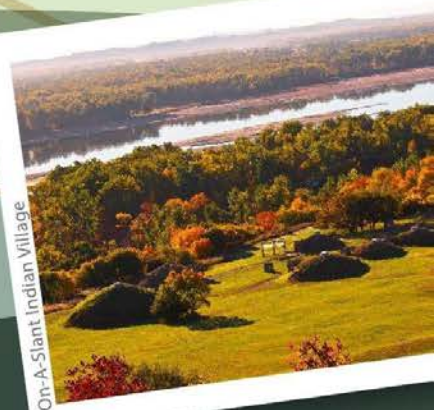

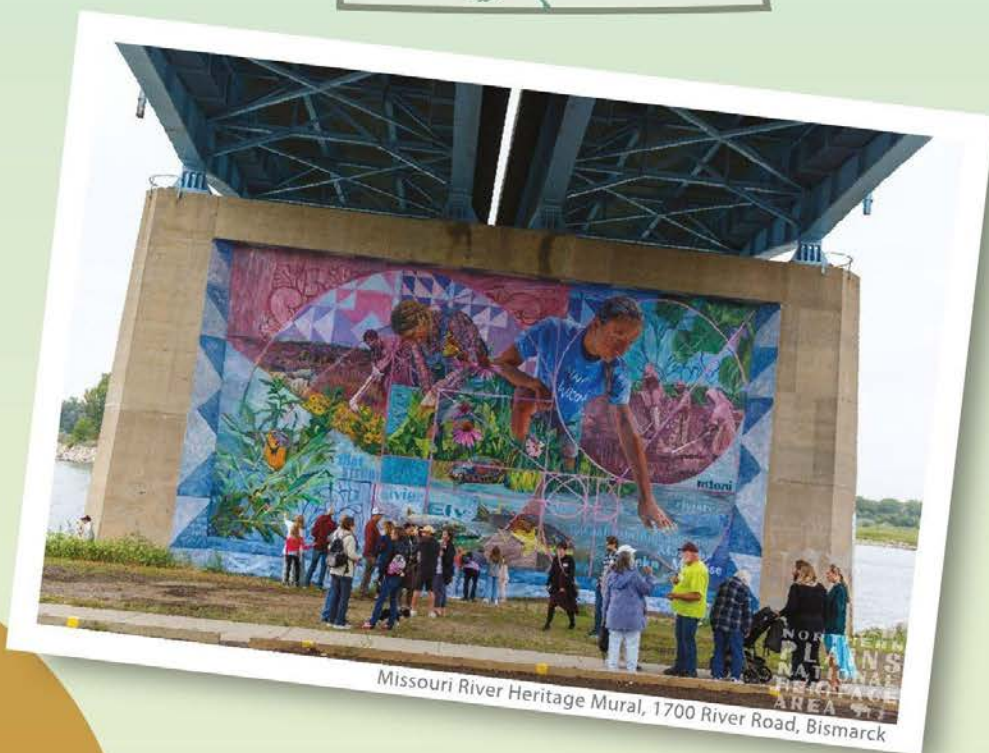

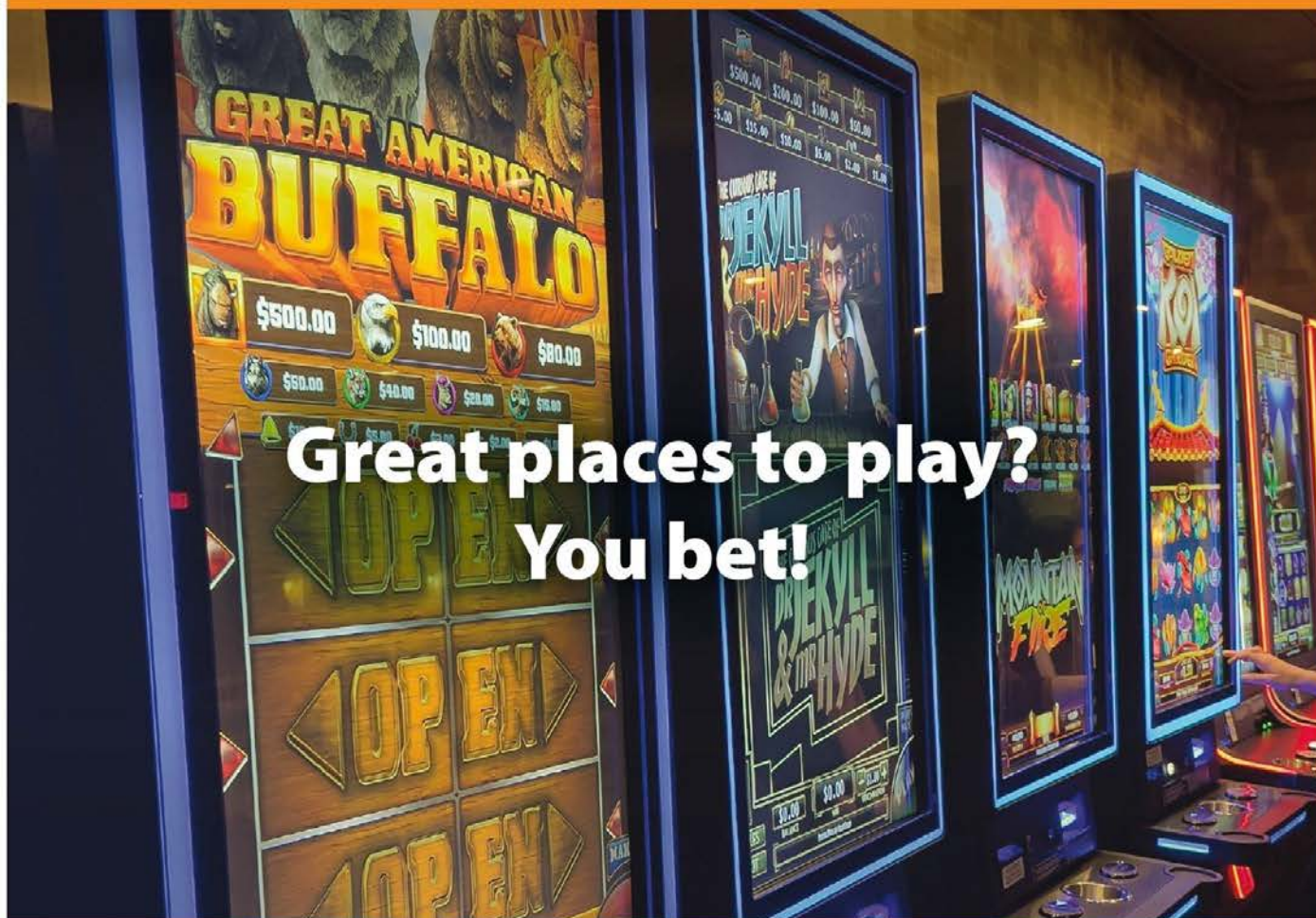

FORT ABRAHAM LINCOLN STATE PARK

History comes to life at Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park, 4480 Fort Lincoln Road, Mandan.

Rich in both military and early Native American history, Fort Abraham Lincoln was once an important infantry and cavalry post. It was from this fort that Lt. Col. George Armstrong Custer and the 7th Cavalry rode out on their ill-fated expedition against the Sioux at the Little Big Horn. So, take a trip back to 1875 where the General's staff still entertains guests with stories of Libby, the General, and the time they spent in Dakota Territory. Portions of the military post, including the Custer House, have been reconstructed.

Popular with visitors is On-A-Slant Indian Village. Six reconstructed earthlodges depict the lifestyle of the Mandan Indians, who occupied this site from about 1575-1781.

The park's Visitor Center houses the nation's best display of Mandan artifacts and history, along with items of interest on Lewis and Clark and General Custer.

The hills above Fort Abraham Lincoln provide a great view of the Missouri River valley with three reconstructed blockhouses standing guard over both the fort and the village.

A 97-unit modern campground and comfort station is located in a scenic wooded area adjacent to the Heart and Missouri River with picnic sites and playground equipment. Multi-use trails will take you along the sloping hills, open prairie and into the woods. Visitors will be treated to a panoramic view of the Missouri River valley from the park's nature and historic trails. The park also has 2 cabins and 4 primitive campsites with horse corrals.

Guided tours run May into September; cost is \$8 per adult, \$5 per student. The park is open all year round. Park entrance fees are \$7 per vehicle, \$35 for an annual single vehicle entrance permit and \$61.25 for an annual family entrance permit (members of the same household get two annual permits).

NORTH DAKOTA STATE CAPITOL

Visitors to the Capitol will find a unique blend of prairie-themed Art Deco styling. Designed in monumental scale with majestic proportions, visitors will see chandeliers representing heads of wheat; ceiling lighting representing the sunrise, moon and stars; and bronze elevator doors depicting the history of life on the prairie. The observation deck, located on the 18th floor of the Capitol tower, provides a 360-degree view of the Bismarck-Mandan area. The grounds are equally spectacular with many monuments and statues, as well as an arboretum trail with more than 75 types of trees.

The Capitol is in the heart of Bismarck at 600 East Boulevard Avenue. The visitor entrance is on the south side and ample visitor parking is available.

Free guided tours of the Capitol building are available Monday-Friday at 9, 10 and 11:00 a.m. and 1, 2 and 3:00 p.m. Tours normally run 45-50 minutes long. Self-guided tours are also available during the week. Visit omb.nd.gov/capitol-complex for up-to-date hours and further information.

NORTH DAKOTA HERITAGE CENTER & STATE MUSEUM

Located on the State Capitol Grounds, this popular tourist attraction is the largest museum in North Dakota and is free to the public. Adults and children will enjoy exhibits and hands-on experiences covering the history of our unique state. Take in rare dinosaur fossils, extensive Native American pottery and beadwork collections, a homesteading shack, military objects, and learn the stories of North Dakota's national leadership in agriculture, energy, and additional areas. Explore 600 million years of history in the museum and a children's play area.

Adaptation Gallery: Geologic Time takes visitors back in time 600 million years. View dinosaurs, crocodiles, and early sea creatures. Through games and interactives, you can discover fascinating stories of evolving geology and the earliest life in North Dakota.

Innovation Gallery: Early Peoples traces the land and lives of the first known people who lived in the geography of this region. This gallery highlights the beauty of the state's Native American collections with more than 1,000 artifacts on exhibit. For a unique experience, step into a special circular area featuring a large, hand-painted mural interpreting the thriving trade center of Double Ditch Indian Village on the Missouri River in 1550.

Inspiration Gallery: Yesterday and Today showcases the state and its people from the mid-1880s up to current times. Learn about North Dakota's innovators and gamechangers who are influencing the world. Explore early settlements and traditions that helped shape today's communities and cultural expressions. Step inside a soda shop. Connect yesterday's people to the North Dakota of today.

The Governors Gallery: Explore an engaging temporary exhibit in this gallery, either created by our staff or brought in for visitors to enjoy. Just outside this gallery, discover art by regional artists that also rotates each year.

Discover exciting things to see and do around every corner! Find the rare dinomummy and then walk through the North Dakota Native American Hall of Honor. Shop for gifts and souvenirs created by local artisans. Savor a wonderful selection of coffees, teas, and breakfast and lunch selections at the El Coqui Café. Outdoors, walk the nature trails and view sculptures on the beautiful Capitol grounds. Explore the North Dakota Heritage Center & State Museum at 612 E. Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, 701-328-2666. STATE ARCHIVES

In the State Archives, you can trace North Dakota ancestors and find a vast array of primary sources for research projects. Explore books, manuscript collections, music, photographs, newspapers, film, and additional resources. The knowledgeable staff will help bring voices of the past to life. The State Archives is inside the North Dakota Heritage Center & State Museum on the State Capitol Grounds at 612 E. Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, 701-328-2091. Open Monday through Friday and the second Saturday of each month. Visit history.nd.gov for hours and additional information.

CAMP HANCOCK STATE HISTORIC SITE

Camp Hancock, located on Bismarck's busy Main Avenue, was an early military supply depot and Signal Corps office built as part of the U.S. government's efforts to construct a transcontinental railroad. Take in three amazing attractions here. The former officers' quarters, built in 1872, is the oldest standing building in Bismarck. Inside, explore exhibits about local history and the U.S. Weather Bureau office once housed here. Then pop into the picturesque 1881 Bread of Life Church, the oldest church in the city. Notice its stunning architecture and recently restored stained glass windows. Next, get an up-close view of a 1909 Northern Pacific Railway steam locomotive exhibited next to Bismarck's active railroad tracks.

Admission to Camp Hancock is free. For open days and hours, visit history.nd.gov or call 701-328-9528.

FORMER GOVERNORS' MANSION STATE HISTORIC SITE

The elegant Former Governors' Mansion in downtown Bismarck was home to North Dakota's first families from 1893 to 1960. The architecture was unusual in this city when it was built in 1884. Inside, discover original furnishings and fixtures, exposed wallpaper samples and learn about the political upheavals experienced by the governors and their families. Play with replica toys in the attic playroom. Then take in the exhibit, *From Buckets of Oats to Quarts of Oil*, in the adjacent carriage house. In summer, stroll the beautiful flower gardens featuring over 60 varieties of heirloom plants. This facility is available to rent for private events.

Admission is free to the mansion, located at 320 E. Avenue B. For open days and hours, visit history.nd.gov or call 701-328-9528.

RAGING RIVERS WATERPARK

Wild and wet family fun awaits visitors to Raging Rivers Waterpark, located at 2600 46th Avenue SE, Mandan, just off I-94, along the Bismarck Expressway.



RAGING RIVERS WATERPARK

Features include a "Lazy River," so jump aboard an inner tube and float around the 850-foot waterway. The AquaPlay features geysers, water cannons, 300-gallon tip bucket, water guns, tunnels and waterslides just for the little ones. Towering 66 feet over the waterpark, two speed slides provide the ultimate thrill. Take the plunge on the Lightning Speed Slide, starting off in total darkness. When you see daylight, you drop straight down in what feels like a total freefall. Scream as you speed down the Double Drop Speed Slide. Each drop gives you the thrill of being airborne. Climb aboard a single or double inner tube and splash down the two, 45-foot-high tube slides. The River Run Tube Slide provides a constant rush of water over your body with each curve and bend of the slide. The Dark Hole Tube Slide offers the same heart pounding experience, but in total darkness until splashdown!

Raging Rivers has something for everyone, from a relaxing float down the Lazy River to the Sandbar Concessions to satisfy your hunger. Private rental areas available, it is a great place for your next party or special occasion. Open daily starting in June through the end of August. The daily schedule is weather permitting. COMMERCIAL VESSELS LEWIS & CLARK AND MNISHOSHE

All heritage flows from the Missouri River in central North Dakota. Cruise the 105-passenger commercial vessel *Lewis & Clark* or the 14-passenger commercial vessel *Mnishoshe* from the Port of Bismarck on River Road, May through September. Heritage excursion information can be found at www.lewisandclarkriverboat.com, www.mnishoshe.com, by calling 701-255-4233 or by e-mailing riverboat@fortlincoln.org.

HERITAGE RIVER LANDING

Located where riverboat *Lewis & Clark* docks on River Road is the Heritage River Landing (aka, The Landing), an historically inspired post-and-beam river warehouse that is open year-round. The Landing connects residents and visitors to the heritage of the Missouri River in central North Dakota. It serves as the orientation headquarters of the Northern Plains National Heritage Area (NPNHA), one of the sixty-two National Heritage Areas in the United States. Stand before the Missouri River Heritage Mural that is four interstate lanes wide before walking over the etched granite NPNHA map upon entering The Landing and check out the interactive NPNHA kiosk inside. Visitors can receive their official NPS NPNHA Passport Stamp at this location. Also within The Landing is the northern plains heritage education gift shop, open year-round, and a place where visitors can acquire passenger tickets for *Lewis & Clark* or the commercial pontoon *Mnishoshe* during the operational months of May to September. Huckleberry House restaurant is also located inside.



NORTH DAKOTA'S GATEWAY TO SCIENCE

FRANCES LEACH HIGH PRAIRIE ARTS & SCIENCE COMPLEX

Located at 1810 Schafer Street, Bismarck, the Frances Leach High Prairie Arts & Science Complex is home to Dakota West Arts Council, 701-222-6640, Shade Tree Players, 701-258-4998, Theo Art School, 701-222-6452 and TruNorth Theatre Co., 701-557-1600. For information on performances, classes and upcoming events, please contact the individual partners.

EAGLE SCULPTURES

"Gathering of Visions," a public art creation by the students of United Tribes Technical College, is part of the Missouri Valley Legacy Trail at Bismarck's Sertoma Park, near the entrance of Dakota Zoo. This impressive display of five different eagles on a ceramic circle. The second sculpture, "Reflections," faces the Missouri River along River Road at Steamboat Park. The reflective sphere surrounded by an eagle represents Mother Earth and reflects the area's natural beauty. The third sculpture, "Rising Eagle," is located in Pioneer Park and offers visitors a bench, within the sculpture, to rest and reflect. The final sculpture, "The Keeper," is located near shelter number nine in Sertoma Park. For more information, visit www.bisparks.org.

ALLEY 5.5

The Bismarck Art Alley Program is a public art project partnership between the Dakota West Arts Council, a 2016 Leadership Bismarck Mandan Project Team and the community of Bismarck. The purpose is to foster ongoing efforts to create public art in Bismarck and create a sense of place and build a stronger, more connected community. Alley 5.5, an outdoor gallery located in downtown Bismarck halfway between Broadway and Main Avenues just off of 5th Street, features murals by local and regional artists depicting the culture and heritage of North Dakota. LEWIS AND CLARK INTERPRETIVE CENTER AND FORT MANDAN

The Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center highlights some of the area's most famous of countless travelers and residents over hundreds of years along this special stretch of the Missouri River. Learn about the Corps of Discovery expedition and the people of Mandan and Hidatsa villages along the river. Take in engaging exhibits, hundreds of period artifacts, world-class art collections and beautiful views from the observation deck. Art by Karl Bodmer, who chronicled Plains Indian life and landscapes along the Missouri River, is showcased along with works by George Catlin.

Self-guided tours and interpreters offer visitors a focused view of the rich heritage of the northern Plains. The Museum Store specializes in regionally made crafts, jewelry, art, books and more. A rest area is open 24 hours. 2576 8th Street SW, Washburn. 701-462-8535.

Two miles west of the Interpretive Center, step back in time at the reconstructed Fort Mandan, a full-size replica of the winter home of the Lewis and Clark expedition from 1804–1805. Their time here was characterized by the hospitality of Mandan and Hidatsa peoples. Explore furnished quarters that bring to life the daily activities of Corp members. Stroll the river path and take a selfie with a large sculpture of Seaman, Captain Meriwether Lewis' dog. In the Visitor Center, explore the store and children's play area. Find hours and admission rates for both sites at history.nd.gov.

STEAMBOAT PARK

The Yellowstone Steamboat at Steamboat Park is 60 feet long. Replicating the boats of that time, the vessel will give you a feeling of what it was like to travel along the river before the railroads arrived. Located on River Road along the Missouri River in Bismarck, Steamboat Park is part of the Missouri Valley Legacy Trail and is now the home for the eagle sculpture, "Reflections." It provides information and experiences relative to the cultures and history before, during and after the Lewis and Clark Expedition. For more information, visit www.bisparks.org.

CHIEF LOOKING'S VILLAGE HISTORIC SITE

For a glorious view of the Missouri River, and to visit the site

of an 18th-century Mandan village, travel to the hill above Pioneer Park, 2023 Burnt Boat Drive, Bismarck. The site is open from early spring to late fall. Free admission. Enjoy the on-site interpretation panels, walking trail and Sonali's Garden on the south end of the overlook. This memorial garden, along with the beautiful view, is a quiet place for reflection. BUCKSTOP JUNCTION HISTORIC TOWN

Step into the historic buildings and hear the stories of the people who moved here, built the towns and homesteaded the prairies of North Dakota. These are actual buildings dating from 1875 to the 1940's, moved to this site by the Missouri Valley Historical Society for preservation. They offer visitors a feel of the Missouri River Valley during the turn of the last century and the first part of this century. Buckstop Junction is supported their events, tours, membership, facility rentals, donations and sales from the vintage shoppe. Located at 3805 E. Bismarck Expressway.

DOUBLE DITCH INDIAN VILLAGE STATE HISTORIC SITE

Explore Double Ditch Indian Village, covering about 24 acres. This Mandan village is one of the most spectacular archaeological sites on the Northern Plains. Overlooking the Missouri River, the village was a busy, densely populated hub of trade and industry founded around 1490. The people who lived there for about 300 years created a major trading center. Learn the full story from interpretive signs as you walk along a beautiful, paved, riverside path. Explore the remains of earthlodges and fortification ditches. Stand inside the stone shelter constructed in the 1930s. View Square Buttes on the horizon, a traditional landmark separating the Hidatsa territory and the Mandan territory. Launch a kayak on the shoreline.

This site is north of Bismarck. For information and directions, visit history.nd.gov or call 701-328-2666. Admission is free and the site is open year round.

KNIFE RIVER INDIAN VILLAGES NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

This site, located one-half mile north of Stanton at 564 County Road 37, was once home to several Hidatsa villages with a total population estimated at over 3,000. The park interprets Hidatsa history and culture, as well as the perspectives on them provided by important Euro-American visitors. Among these visitors were Lewis and Clark, who here obtained the services of Sacagawea and her husband, Toussaint Charbonneau. Visible remains of earthlodge dwellings, cache pits, fortification ditches and travois trails are in an extraordinarily fine state of preservation. A ranger-staffed visitor center with museum exhibits, a short film and a furnished earthlodge provide interpretation of the site. You can enjoy over 12 miles of self-guided history and nature trails. Throughout the year, ranger-guided experiences are available (please provide advance notice in winter). Call 701-745-3300 or visit the park website at www.nps.gov/knri for further details.

NORTH DAKOTA STATE RAILROAD MUSEUM

The Railroad Museum in Mandan is celebrating 40 years. The Museum was established in 1985 and has 5 acres of land in Northwest Mandan. They have 13 large rolling stock: 1 SW1 Switcher Diesel Engine, a Goat or Mule Diesel Engine, three Caboose, a Tank car, a Flat-bed car, 5 Box cars and 1 Ice

Refrigerator car, several which are open for viewing. They also have the 1890 Steele Depot, a 1947 Railway Express Agency delivery truck, 3 speeder shacks and other outside exhibits. The 3 main buildings contain many railroad artifacts, model train displays, a Kidz Zone, a Railroad Hall of Fame display and a gift store. The Mandan Historical Society has a separate museum of local photos and Mandan history. The museum is open every day June 1–August 31, from 1–4 p.m. Special days at the museum are Father's Day; Watermelon Days on the 3rd Sunday in July; and Railroad Days on the 4th Sunday in August, when there are Mini Train rides, hobo signs, Scavenger Hunt and other activities for kids and families. 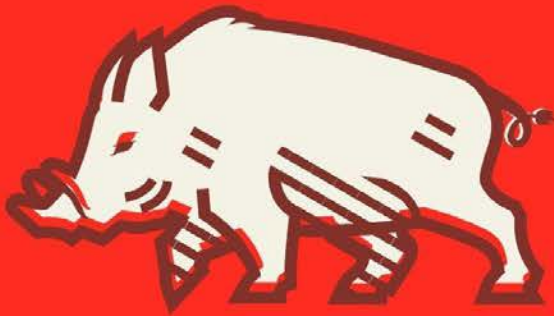

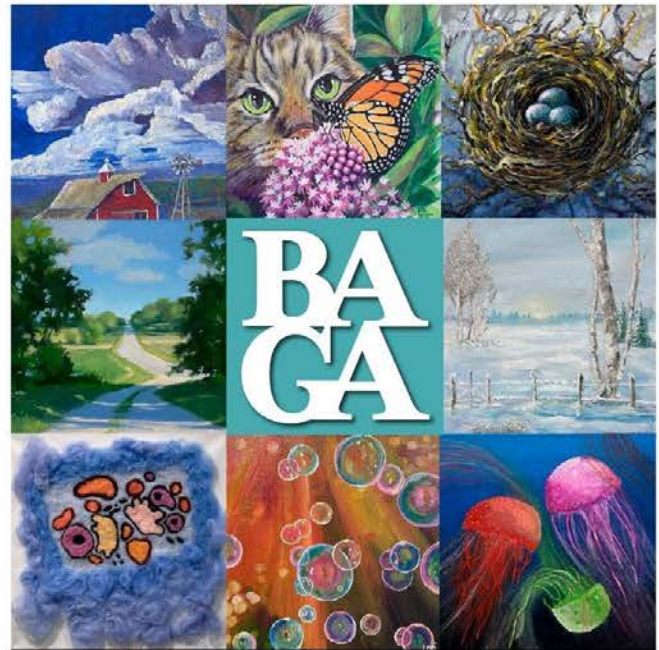

Bismarck depot gem of downtown

A historic landmark, the Bismarck railroad depot has been returned to its original character to become a downtown entertainment hub.

The Northern Pacific railroad depot was built in 1901 as a transportation hub, designed by architect Cass Gilbert. After designing the Minnesota Capitol, Gilbert shipped excess marble from that project to Bismarck to use as crushed marble on the depot's exterior.

"It's beautiful material that's withstood the 100-plus years since it was pressed into the exterior of the building," says Cam Knutson, owner of Knutson Companies, which is developing the property.

That's just one of the original elements preserved in Gilbert's first Spanish-influenced mission design building.

"We've been really diligent about updating everything, getting this building ready for the next 50 years, but at the same time making sure we're very mindful of the historic features of the building and keeping those," Knutson says.

Knutson remembers sitting across the street, admiring the property in 2019.

"I'm looking outside at the depot property, which is dark and empty, and I'm thinking, 'Gosh, someone's gotta do something. What a gorgeous property,'" he says. "I was

very well aware of how difficult it was likely going to be to restore that building and bring it back to life."

But Knutson acquired the depot in 2022 after it had been empty for several years.

Since acquiring the depot, Knutson Companies revitalized the cherished landmark, enhancing its historical significance while modernizing it for contemporary use.

"You have this iconic historic building and thinking back to those original decades of it being the hub and the centerpiece of all the commerce, it really was the center of the universe for those early years of Bismarck. The thought of that coming back full circle again and it again being an active building, an active site, with events bringing people together, is extremely exciting. I think there's such a need for it here in Bismarck," Knutson says.

"We proceeded with the mindset of treating this as a community project," he says.

After major renovations, the building now has two tenants.

The Theodore Roosevelt Presidential Library Foundation will utilize the entire second floor for its headquarters to support construction and future operations of the presidential library in Medora.

"I can imagine back in those early years, the center of all activity in Bismarck was the depot. It was the front door to Bismarck," Knutson says.

And one of those arriving at the Bismarck depot was President Roosevelt enroute to Medora.

"That's another thing that was super cool to have that come full circle, knowing if you could pick one property in Bismarck that has the strongest connection to President Roosevelt, it's this property," Knutson says.

Funatix Events, the sister company of the Bismarck Larks baseball team, will establish its headquarters in a 1,300-square-foot addition on the east side of the depot.

Funatix Events specializes in event management, partnering with iconic community events such as the Bismarck Marathon, Mandan Rodeo and Dacotah Speedway.

The exterior of the property was redone with a comprehensive plan to make it an event space for the community, Knutson describes.

The exterior space, spanning over 30,000 square feet, has been transformed into a multi-use site capable of hosting various community events and serving as a parking facility. This redevelopment aims to make the depot a

central entertainment and gathering hub, spearheaded by Funatix Events.

One of the first events in the space was a successful Bismarck Food Truck Festival in 2024.

"It proves our thesis that people want more of these events and in the setting downtown and what better spot than the depot," Knutson says.
