Vast seas of waving prairie grass interrupted only by wild roses, crocuses and game – this describes the Carrington area prior to the 1880's. Before the pioneers came to the Carrington area, the region was important to Native American people. You can see Native American and pioneer history displays, which are featured in collections of artifacts at the Foster County Museum and the Chieftain Conference Center in Carrington.

Like most North Dakota communities, Carrington can trace its development to the arrival of the railroad. By 1882, the Northern Pacific line ran through the unnamed prairie settlement. In 1883, Foster County was organized with Carrington named the county




