#### CAVLANDIC TRAIL

The Cavlandic Trail is a highly trafficked 6.5 mile paved trail that runs between the City of Cavalier and Icelandic State Park/Cavalier Country Club.

If you make the trek along the entire trail you might notice the elevation change from Cavalier to Icelandic State Park – it is approximately 119 feet!

# COMMUNITY GARDEN & POLLINATOR GARDEN

Another great aspect of Cavalier is the Community Giving Garden. A giving garden is a shared experience for the residents of Cavalier. Fruits, vegetables and herbs are planted here to be shared with anyone who can benefit from it! This innovative idea stemmed from our local public health unit starting a program where grant money was used to help defray the cost of growing these gardens. A lot of community members don't have access to fresh produce so these raised garden beds provide that opportunity. The city of Cavalier loved this idea so much they plan to continue the giving garden for years to come!



Cavaliers pollinator garden has a wide variety of plants that bloom from early spring into late fall. The plants are native to the region. Pollinators are an important part of plant reproduction. This pollinator garden helped to produce five monarch butterflies in 2023. Monarchs have been placed on the endangers species list. Check out the beauty of this garden and hopefully spot a pollinator or two.
