North Dakota's craft beer industry's rich brews, robust flavors and unique twists on traditional styles are quickly becoming legendary. So, too, is North Dakota's array of wineries offering signature spirits. With rich agricultural roots, North Dakota takes pride in being one of the nation's biggest barley producers. Many wineries and breweries incorporate North Dakota agricultural products like wheat, honey and fruit, along with other unique local ingredients, into their beverages.



Grape growing has occurred in North Dakota for years, but only in the last 20 years has it started to become a commercial industry. The North Dakota Grape and Wine Association serves commercial and amateur fruit and grape growers and facilitates education and growth of the industry.
