

From leisurely shore fishing to serious walleye angling, North Dakota has some of the most extraordinary fishing anywhere. With more than 400 lakes and rivers full of walleye, perch, bass and northern pike, there's a good chance your line will stay busy. Feed your competitive side in tournaments like the Governor's Cup and the Devils Lake Ice Fishing Tournament. Whatever your style, our fishing season never closes.





FISH THE BIG THREE

DEVILS LAKE

The state's largest natural body of water has several resorts, campgrounds and Spirit Lake Casino. You'll find excellent ice fishing for perch, walleye and northern pike in the winter, and walleye, pike and white bass on the open water.

LAKE SAKAKAWEA

This amazing 479-square-mile reservoir — famous for its walleye, northern pike and Chinook salmon — has numerous bays surrounded by cut banks and badlands bluffs. It offers dozens of public boat ramps and several marinas, including Lewis and Clark State Park, Lake Sakakawea State Park and Fort Stevenson State Park. You will also find many privately owned campgrounds and resorts including Lund's Landing, Indian Hills Resort, Tobacco Gardens Resort & Marina, Van Hook Resort, Dakota Waters Resort and more.

MISSOURI RIVER INCLUDING LAKE OAHE

The free-flowing river offers a good setting for walleye in the spring and fall. The far northwestern reaches of the Missouri in North Dakota is one of the better spots in the country to snag a giant paddlefish in May. Lake Oahe stretches from south-central North Dakota into South Dakota. Anglers can find walleye and northern pike in this area, but there are also crappie, catfish, sturgeon and white bass.



GAME FISHING SEASON NEVER CLOSES

In North Dakota, you can fish 365 days of the year if you choose. Park your boat when the lakes freeze and bring out your icehouse to jig for walleye, perch and bluegill — or try darkhouse spearfishing for northern pike. Licenses are good for most species April 1 through March 31.

HOTSPOTS

North Dakota Game & Fish manages hundreds of fishing waters besides the big three. Large reservoirs with highly active fishing include Lake Darling, Lake Ashtabula, Jamestown Reservoir, Lake Tschida and Lake Audubon. Anglers can find some of the best fishing spots at these locations:

Around Jamestown Marina and Five Mile Corner



Weekly Fishing Report



Here's an invitation for you. It's time to find out why hunting is a favorite tradition in North Dakota. From our wetlands that are prime waterfowl habitat to the hills and prairies that are home to deer, pheasant and grouse, you'll find the very best hunting in North Dakota.





WATERFOWL

North Dakota is home to the Central Flyway, a waterfowl superhighway for millions of migrating ducks and geese. Our rivers, lakes and wetlands stretch far and wide, offering premier waterfowl habitat.

WATERFOWL SEASONS

Ducks may be hunted during the waterfowl season, usually opening early October. An early resident waterfowl season opens late September. Canada geese can be hunted during waterfowl season or in the early August season. Spring snow goose season runs from mid-February to mid-May, peaking in late March.



DUCKS

Duck species are diverse in North Dakota. Altogether, hunters have a total daily limit of 6 ducks with specific limits on mallards, scaup, wood ducks, redheads, pintails, canvasbacks, blue-winged teal and mergansers. Possession limits are three times the daily limits. Other species for hunting may include coots, wigeon, buffleheads, goldeneye, gadwalls, greenwinged teal, northern shovelers, ring-necked ducks and ruddy ducks.

CANADA GOOSE

The Canada goose is common during migration and nesting seasons in North Dakota. Some geese will winter along river systems where open water is available providing more opportunities to hunt waterfowl later in the season.

SNOW GOOSE (SPRING LIGHT GOOSE)

Waterfowl hunting, near Lidgerwood

Snows and blues are medium-sized geese 25-31", weighing 4-6.5 lbs., and different color phases. There is no daily limit nor is there a possession limit for snow geese in the spring season.

SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

North Dakota Game and Fish offers wheelchair accessible boat ramps and shooting ranges, special hunting permits and a tracked wheelchair available by reservation.

All hunters must possess a certificate, a general game and habitat license, a federal waterfowl stamp and HIP registration as a prerequisite.

ZONE RESTRICTED LICENSE

There are three zones for nonresident waterfowlers to choose from. See Game and Fish for more details.

BIG GAME & VARMINTS

Nonresidents may purchase white-tailed deer archery tags online. Bighorn sheep, deer gun and any deer archery tags are drawn by lottery open to nonresidents. Prairie dogs and coyotes may be hunted year-round with purchased nonresident tags.


WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS

North Dakota offers extensive hunting opportunities on PLOTS, wildlife management areas, and waterfowl production areas. Nonresidents can hunt PLOTS and wildlife areas one week after the pheasant season opens. Hunting on private land requires the landowner's permission if the land is posted (physically or electronically). Unposted private land may be hunted without permission unless otherwise restricted by law.

UPLAND GAME

The grass-covered rolling hills and agricultural land of North Dakota provide extraordinary habitat for abundant pheasant, grouse and partridge populations. If you've never experienced upland game hunting here, you are in for a treat.

PHEASANT

Pheasant can be found statewide in North Dakota. Traditionally the highest concentration of birds have been found in the southwestern part of the state.

Sharp-tailed grouse can be found statewide. Higher populations of grouse are found in the far western part of the state including the badlands

HUNGARIAN PARTRIDGE

Hungarian partridge's primary range is across western and central North Dakota.

UPLAND GAME SEASONS

The seasons for sharp-tailed grouse and Hungarian partridge open in early September, with pheasant opening in early October. All three species' seasons run to approximately the beginning of the new year.

Pests hitchhike in firewood - don't move it, buy it where you burn it!



Emergld Ash Borer

- Signs and symptoms include: thinning in the canopy, D-shaped exit holes, bark splits revealing tunneling and heavy woodpecker activity
- Has killed hundreds of millions of ash trees
- EAB was detected in LaMoure County, ND in Aug. 2024 and has also been found in Manitoba, MN and SD.





Spongy Moth

- Caterpillars are heavy feeders on a wide range of tree and shrub species
- Yearly defoliation can be detrimental to tree health
- Egg masses are laid on many surfaces so can easily be moved by humans
- Caught in traps rarely in North Dakota
