

Wally the Walleye Main Street

Garrison is known as the "Walleye Capitol of the World." Home of Wally the Walleye, the 26 foot Walleye located at the end of Main Street in the City Park. This designation can be attributed to the bountiful fishing opportunities that Lake Sakakawea provides.

Bobber Water Tower

The Garrison Community is proud of Lake Sakakawea and the opportunities it gives our community. When our community water tower was being built a group of citizens suggested that the new water tower be painted like a bobber with the "Get Hooked on Garrison" logo. Quickly these business leaders and our City Council came up with a plan to make this Garrison's newest attraction to replace our previous "Hot & Cold" Water Towers!

Custer Mine Interpretive Site


Highway 37/Highway 83 Intersection

The Custer Mine Interpretive site is a parcel of land that showcases a piece of Garrison's early coal mining history. Formerly the Truax-Taer Mine, the site was established in 1989 as part of North Dakota's Centennial celebration. The site includes signage explaining the history of the area and a scenic overlook. A pond is also nearby for fishing.

Queen Elizabus

Garrison is Home of the Authentic Queen Elizabus Double Decker English Bus. Take a ride on the Queen at our annual Dickens Village Festival. Garrison earned the title "Christmas Capitol of North Dakota" because of the highly popular annual Dickens Village Festival.



Trolley

The Wally Trolley is Garrison's newest addition to its fleet. This trolley, ownded and operated by Garrison Area Improvement Association, made its trek to Garrison at the end of August 2021 from Clearwater, Florida. The Wally Trolley will serve those living in and visiting Garrison by running a route through town and out to Fort Stevenson State Park during the summer months.

Angel of Hope Memorial

Wilderness Park/ 5th St. NE

Dedicated in 2017, the monument provides a location in the community for parents, grandparents, family members, and friends to remember the children that have been lost. Garrison became home to the 6th Angel of Hope Memorial in the State of ND.

A Step Back In Time

Heritage Park & Museum

1st Ave $NW \bullet (701)463-2546$ Preserving the history of Garrison and the surrounding area, the museum features a train depot constructed in 1905 that also serves as a museum for period items. The park also features a country school, a country church, telephone office, two fully furnished homestead houses, and a log cabin.

Fort Stevenson Guardhouse Interpretive Center

1252A ⁴1st Ave NW/ 3 Miles S of Garrison (701)337-5331 or (701)337-5576 The Guardhouse is a replica of the original military guardhouse that was lost when the land it was standing on was flooded by the formation of Lake Sakakawea. The Guardhouse holds artifacts, memorabilia, and history of Fort Stevenson and the Missouri River. The attraction also features a full size three inch rifled cannon.



Bait Your Hook

Lake Sakakawea: The lake named for the Native American woman who joined Lewis and Clark 200 years ago, is the third-largest manmade lake in the United States. It's filled by the Missouri River and contained by the Garrison Dam, the country's fifth largest. This huge lake, with more shoreline than California, is home to numerous species. Walleye is the most popular catch, but anglers can also reel in northern pike, Chinook salmon, smallmouth bass, white bass, yellow perch, crappie, and sauger.

Lake Audubon: Lake Audubon is located near Garrison on U.S. Highway 83. This lake is 16,612 acres in size and features 152.8 miles of Shoreline. It is 59.90 feet deep at its deepest point and anglers can expect to catch a variety of fish including walleye, smallmouth bass, and northern pike. Audubon Lake, a sister lake to Lake Sakakawea, was also formed with the construction of the Garrison Dam near Riverdale, N.D. The two lakes are separated by an embankment, which carries US Highway 83.

Garrison Dam National Fish hatchery Provides management and production of many freshwater fishes for the Missouri River Dam development projects, National Wildlife Refuges, Native American waters, and state programs of North Dakota. Visitors are welcome to the hatchery for a close-up view of the fish production process. A visitor center complete with five 400 gallon aguariums will give you the pleasure of viewing the fishes of North Dakota in their environment. Daily tours, free admission, are available at 11:00am or 1:00pm from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The hatchery also has over 3 miles of trails that provide an excellent opportunity for wildlife observation & bird watching. Hiking, mountain biking, cross country skiing, and snowshoeing can be enioved.

Garrison Dam & Powerhouse

The Garrison Dam is the fifth largest earthen dam structure in the United States with a volume content of 66,500,000 cubic vards of fill material. Lake Sakakawea, the reservoir created by Garrison Dam, is the third largest reservoir in the U.S. At its maximum pool elevation 1854' mean sea level, the reservoir holds about 24 million acre-feet of water. The lake is 178 miles long, has over 1530 miles of shoreline, and covers 382,000 surface acres. Garrison Dame provides hydroelectric power production, irrigation, flood damage reduction, navigation, fish and wildlife, municipal and industrial water supply, water quality and recreation. Walk-in tours are available from June 4-August 1 on Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays at 2pm.



Wolf Creek Winery: We craft fine wines from both locally grown fruit and grapes as well as grapes from some of this country's finest vineyards. Our surroundings bring us the inspiration to create delicious wines that will bring pleasure to any palate.

Garrison Dam: is 522 ft long, 163 ft tall, and 134 ft wide on offers 5 power generating turbines that feed power to homes across multiple states.

Arikara Fitness & Recreational

Center: 1104 Warrior St. White Shield ND 58775: Opening its doors in November of 2021 the recreational center has lots of amenities offered from an indoor pool with water slide and hot tub, simulated golf, pool tables, dart boards, coffee and tea shop, a full service gym, and hydrotherapy. They also have a conference room and community room with kitchen for all your meeting needs. Falkirk Mine: Falkirk is a surface mining operation with some of the largest earth-moving equipment manufactured today. With an annual production of approximately 8 million tons of lignite coal, Falkirk provides fuel to generate low-cost electricity for 2/3 of rural Minnesota. With the help of Falkirk's 400 full-time employees, Falkirk stands as one of the safest mine operations in the coal industry.
