



There are also several restaurants, bars and brewpubs dotting DeMers Avenue, 3rd Street and our beautiful Greenway Trail System.
- EASTSIDE // Walk across Sorlie Bridge into East Grand Forks and experience that friendly small town vibe at its finest. There you will discover a boardwalk, situated near the Red River, lined with popular homegrown eateries like Blue Moose and Bernie's. Across the street is Cabela's World's Foremost Outfitter, as well as Riverwalk Centre, which features a luxury movie theater and variety of local businesses.
- NORTHSIDE/UND // While here, cheer on our championship University of North Dakota Men's Hockey team at the magnificent Ralph Engelstad Arena. Browse through all the great works at the North Dakota Museum of Art. Then cap it off with a famously delicious Grinder sub at The Red Pepper.
- SOUTHSIDE // Perhaps best known as the part of town where many big box stores, franchise restaurants and the Grand Forks Marketplace reside, it has become a hot spot for locally owned boutiques and bistros, as well. In addition to a prime selection of fine bovine, top-grade chefs here prepare an array of amazing appetizers, superb side dishes, decadent desserts and succulent seafood including the best crab cakes and lobster dip this side of New England.

Dreaming about pizza with pizzazz? Rhombus Guys can make all your foodie fantasies come true. This funky three-level restaurant, with rooftop seating overlooking Downtown, specializes in gourmet pies dubbed Best Pizza in the State by Business Insider. Toppings range from the usual suspects (pepperoni, sausage and peppers) to the more avant-garde (pork loin, shrimp and pickles).






WINE, SPIRITS & BREWS //





Regarded as one of the finest hockey facilities in the world, the magnificent \$100+ million Ralph Engelstad Arena is best known as the home of championship University of North Dakota Hockey but it also plays host to several topnotch concerts and on-ice performances throughout the year. The 400,000 square-foot, five-story arena seats 11,700 and features the largest center-hung videoboard in college hockey. Stop by the Sioux Shop on weekdays, at 1:30 PM, if you'd like to take a guided tour and perhaps pick out some cool UND logo wear.



Where to Stay / The Olive Ann
