



> Red River Zoo 4255 23rd Ave S, Fargo

Open year-round, the Red River Zoo specializes in the care of some of the rarest cold climate species on earth.

All the animals come from similar climate conditions to the Red River Valley... so those camels you see actually love the cold!

Stop by the colored pencil fence – made up of over 1,000 large colored pencils – and ride the antique 1928 carousel during your visit.

> Woodchipper in Fargo 2001 44th St S, Fargo

Although what you see on TV wasn't actually filmed in Fargo, North Dakota, you can still visit a piece of cinematic history – the original Fargo Woodchipper movie prop (and its stunt double) – at the Fargo-Moorhead Visitors Center.

Just off I-94, the Fargo Woodchipper sits ready and waiting for a photo op. The friendly Travel Ambassadors will take your picture as you pretend to push a fake leg into the Fargo "chipper".

Beyond getting a picture with the Woodchipper from Fargo – which is signed by the Coen Brothers – you can also see other memorabilia from the movie, including a signed copy of the original script.

>Fargo Theatre

314 Broadway N, Fargo

Built in 1926 and beautifully restored, the art deco interior serves as an art house theatre. Beyond movies, it's also one of Fargo's top venues for concerts, performing arts, and other live events.

Two hidden gems sit inside: **Wood Chip Marge**, a wooden statue carved in the likeness of Marge Gunderson from the 1996 film, *Fargo*, and **The Mighty Wurlitzer**, a 1926 pipe organ which scored silent movies and is still played today.





Plains Art Museum

704 1st Ave N, Fargo

The largest accredited art museum in North Dakota, Plains Art Museum is located in a renovated International Harvester warehouse.

This free art museum's permanent collection has over 4,000 national, international, and regional works, including Native American art.

Reserve a guided tour for just \$4 per person and have a Plains Art educator show you around or wander at your own pace.



>Downtown Fargo

Fargo's main cultural district fills the most historic section of the city. If you're looking for uniquely local, Downtown is the place to go with tons of shops, local restaurants, and bars lining the streets.

Start your day with craft coffee (pg. 42), then explore local art, get your picture with the Fargo Theatre marquee, buy souvenirs, and shop at local boutiques (pg. 44).

Cap the night off with bustling nightlife, live entertainment, and perfectly crafted drinks.



>Bonanzaville, USA

1351 Main Ave W, West Fargo

Named after the large Bonanza farms that dominated the prairie of the Old West, this pioneer village has 40+ buildings that have been relocated here from across the region.

Wander through Fargo's first house, a country schoolhouse, a saloon and hotel, a prairie church, and a fully-stocked mercantile store. You might even get to talk to a docent in period dress about what life was like on the prairie.

Besides the pioneer village, Bonanzaville has over 400,000 artifacts from railroad gear to vintage aircraft to an entire building full of hundreds of antique organs.

Want an immersive experience? Join one of their **murder mystery dinners**, or explore the pioneer village after dark on a **paranormal tour** of Bonanzaville.

However you decide to visit, you'll gain valuable insight into our earliest settlers, how they lived, what they possessed, and the challenges they faced.

> Hjemkomst Center & Replica Norwegian Stave Church 202 1st Ave N, Moorhead

Shaped like a big white tent adjacent to the Red River, the Hjemkomst Center has something special inside: a full-size replica Viking ship.

Immerse yourself in the Hjemkomst ship's story through videos and by wandering around its massive hull. Then, check out the art and local history exhibits in the basement.

The Viking ship isn't the only shrine to the region's Scandinavian culture. Just outside on the banks of the Red River, you'll find the replica Hopperstad Stave Church.

Designed as an exact replica of the Stave church that stands in Vik, Norway, the church was built by a local man, Guy Paulson, and serves as an immersive educational exhibit offering tours every hour where you can step inside and learn the history of the Stave churches in Norway.

Comstock House

506 8th St S, Moorhead

Built in 1882 by an influential lawyer and businessman, Solomon Comstock, this Victorian home was the most expensive house on the block.

Reserve a guided tour and learn about its incredible residents and life in the early days on the prairie.



Rourke Art Callery + Museum 521 Main Ave, Moorhead

Located in Downtown Moorhead, the Rourke is housed in a beautiful neoclassical building that is now on the National Register of Historic Places.

Curated by a local art aficionado, James Tiernan O'Rourke, the massive permanent collection and rotating exhibits aim to show the art of our time and place.

> The Original Moorhead

24 8th St S, Moorhead

As one of the oldest original stores this Dairy Queen doesn't have to follow all modern franchise rules, meaning you won't find another DQ like this.

Walk up to the counter (open March 1 - October 31) for original DQ treats like Monkey Tails, Mr. Malties, or Chipper Sandwiches.

The famous Dilly Bar was invented at this very location, so try one of these handdipped creations while you take a photo with the 16-foot-tall Dilly Bar statue!



Fargo Air Museum 1609 19th Ave N, Fargo

Wander through two hangars full of aircraft ranging from a Wright Brothers' flyer to the Global Hawk unmanned surveillance aircraft. 90% of the planes you'll see inside are still able to fly so you might even see one take to the skies while you're in town.

Wanting to explore on a tour? Step into the past with a veteran docent and hear about which planes they may have flown when they were in the service, or walk it on your own and have the Talking Trails app show you the way.

Interactive displays allow you to read all about the aircraft you're seeing... and some you can even hop inside!

Fun fact: The Air Museum is petfriendly, so feel free to bring your furry friends along.



> Roger Maris Museum 3902 13th Ave S, Fargo

Tucked inside West Acres Mall, this Museum pays homage to the great baseball player of the 60s. Watch historic footage in a theater with actual Yankee seats and see many artifacts from Roger's youth and care.

Per his wishes, the museum is accessible and free to all, so stop by and take a peek at the memorabilia whenever the mall is open.

The coffee is made from beans roasted in-house and the Moorhead location has loaves of bread to-go.

Take a guided, 60-minute tour, led by an experienced guide, or wander through the three main exhibitions.


The Boiler Room

FARCO Woodchipper

The original iconic **Woodchipper** from the movie *Fargo* is on display at the **Visitors Center**. Stop in and take your picture and grab some souvenirs as well.

>AFTERNOON

Bonanzaville, USA

Wander through original structures relocated here from across the region, including Fargo's first house and many others.

Kroll's Diner

Original 50's-style diner with classic favorites and unique German dishes.

>EVENING

Live music

Some staples are **Dempsey's**, **The Windbreak**, and **The Red Raven Espresso Parlor** but you can't go into many places without stumbling into live music.

NORTH OF NORMAL THINGS TO DO IN FARGO



Colored Pencil Fence:

Found on the **Red River Zoo's** grounds, this is a perfect backdrop for photos as well as sure to be a mood-brightener.



2. Painted Bison Herd:

Fargo's colorful bison herd was painted by local artists and makes for a fun scavenger hunt to find each one.

3. Crazy Tree:

This legendary tree has wild branches and an interesting shape that earns its namesake. Check it out on Concordia College's campus.



4. Rooftop Views at Camp

Lone Tree: 701 Eateries has a fantastic patio area on their rooftop complete with snacks you'll remember from your youth like corn dogs, cheese curds, and nachos.

5. Fargo Mario Wall:

One of Downtown Fargo's many murals, the Mario Wall is reminiscent of the video game and perfect for an interactive picture with the fam.



6 Pie Day at Sons of Norway:

Thursday is Pie Day at our local **Sons of**



Norway, and you must get there early to get a slice. Order your lunch at the front and they'll bring you whatever home-made Norwegian specialty is on the menu that day.

7. Sticksgarden:

Hidden just behind a gas station and hardware store, the **Sticksgarden** is home to a variety of sticks designed by local artists.

8. Rattlesnake Rabbit

Bratwurst: Try this unique specialty at **Wurst Bier Hall** in Downtown Fargo or West Fargo along with some Bavarian pretzels and sauerkraut on the side.

9. Hammock Hangs & Rock Climbs: Nature of

the North has tons of outdoor events like hammock hangs on Monday's as well as an indoor rock wall that's perfect for any level of climber.



10. Viking craft beer heaven – Brewhalla: Drekker

Brewing Company's Viking-themed brewery is located in one of the oldest buildings in Fargo, a Northern Pacific Railroad shop from the 1800s. Grab a pint and look on in awe of the high ceilings in this "Beer Heaven." Fargo's tagline is North of Normal and while it's up for debate what it truly means, basically it's something that celebrates the community and all its quirks. Here is a list of 18 North of Normal things you can do while in the Fargo-Moorhead-West Fargo area.



1. Comedy in the Cellar:

A dedicated comedy club in the basement of **Front Street Taproom**, **The Cellar** brings touring acts as well as local comedians and hosts open-mic nights for those who want to give it a shot.

12. Fargo Woodchipper:

Stop into the **Fargo-Moorhead Visitors Center** and take a picture with the real Woodchipper prop from the iconic movie *Fargo*.

13. Red River Market:

The Red River Market is the area's largest market and happens on Saturdays throughout the summer and early fall. Peruse through



stands with local produce, jams, crafts, and ready-to-eat food while you enjoy music and performances by local artists.

14. Take a winery tour:

You may not know that the area is home to multiple gorgeous wineries. Each has their own varieties of fruit and grape wines that all have their own North Dakota flare.



15. Pay-whatyou-want drip coffee: Twenty Below

Coffee lets you pay for as much coffee as you want/can afford at the moment. Stop in and



give them what you have on hand, and they will provide the delicious drip coffee.

16. Christkindlmarkt:

Each year at the beginning of the holiday season, Downtown Fargo comes alive with a German-themed Christmas market, the **Christkindlmarkt**. Enjoy mulled wine, live music, art demonstrations, and so much more.

17. Moorhead Dairy Queen:

A local favorite, the **Moorhead Dairy Queen** is unlike all other in the franchise. They invented the Dilly Bar and have commemorated the accomplishment with a 16-foot-tall Dilly Bar statue out front.



18. Indoor Ferris Wheel:

Scheels is the largest sporting goods

store in the area and besides being home to a huge selection of sports, sportswear, and footwear, it's also home to a 45-foot-tall Ferris Wheel. Take a ride for just \$1.



FARM to fork HIGHLIGHT

Although Fargo is quite an urban city, there are still agricultural roots in basically everything that we do. Including, but not limited to, the food in our local restaurants. Two new kids on the block stand out when it comes to locally sourced, and Midwestern focused restaurants: Rosewild and 701 Eateries.

>Rosewild

Rosewild is located within the brand-new Jasper Hotel and both the hotel, and the restaurant have consistently kept local makers and growers in mind when creating their business concepts. From the plates (and dog bowls) made by local clay throwers to the local beers they pour you at the bar, everything has fun community touches. And it doesn't stop there, the food is considered "hyperlocal," and the menus are created seasonally to ensure everything is fresh and delectable. Try menu items like the Bison Tartar or the coal-roasted sturgeon or opt for the "Chef's special" which is a family-style meal with a wine pairing that represents the Nordic-plains cooking style.

The space itself feels like a cozy, midcentury modern, Midwestern living room with Prairie Rose wallpaper (North Dakota's state flower) and a hutch full of knickknacks and dishes. The huge fireplace in the lobby helps to encourage the cozy aesthetic with comfortable seating all around while the pillars play homage to the farming community with their silo shape and color. The entire experience is meant to make you feel comfortable yet sophisticated and we think they absolutely nailed it.



4. Würst Bier Hall:

I ordered the spaetzle mac and cheese once, and haven't looked back. I love to add their locally smoked bratwurst! 5. JL Beers: A burger, fresh crispy fries and a brew. That's all you really need in life! Also love to send and receive beer mail (if you know, you know)!



>701 Eateries

Another fantastic Midwestern restaurant with strongagricultural roots is 701 Eateries. With two separate concepts, 701 Eateries truly has something for any mood. The building was originally built in 1919 as Fargo's Acme Dairy and was recently renovated into this gathering place for all to enjoy each other's company, tell stories, and eat some great food. 701 also sources their foods nearby, for example, the Lefse comes from right here in Fargo, the Bison meat comes from New Rockford, ND, and cheeses used on their Nordic Boards and cheese curds comes from Brooten, MN.

The upstairs rooftop area, Camp Lone Tree, is the perfect spot for happy hour on a summer day. It was named for the owner's family hunting camp located near Harvey, ND. The camp-style vibe and open-air seating brings you back to the good-old days of your youth (but with a cocktail in hand this time). While the upstairs is airy and fun, the downstairs has a mysterious, cozy feel with dark tones and a Nordic spirit you can feel throughout. The Prairie Kitchen concept was born out of the idea that the kitchen is the heart of the home and is where most memories are made and that rings true in this space. Their menu is full of classic Midwestern dishes like relish trays and lefse platters alongside a Bison tenderloin and Smörgåsbord plate that's bound to make you nostalgic.

Fargo does not lack craft beverages with a total of 7 local breweries (many of which are regionally and nationally acclaimed for their beer) and a few wineries and cideries mixed in, you'll need to make a weekend out of it to try them all.



>Crafts and Drafts Passport Itinerary

Sure, Fargo is flat, but the beers are anything but. Grab a Crafts and Drafts Passport and follow this itinerary to get to all the stops (and maybe even the bonus stops) in a two-day period. Then, bring the passport into the Fargo-Moorhead Visitors Center and get your free prize!



Stop 1: Junkyard Brewing Company

Experimental brewery that specializes in new and different brews in Moorhead, MN.

Stop 2: Swing Barrel Brewing Company

Baseball-themed brewery in Downtown Moorhead with wheat ales, seltzers, and more on their tap list.

Bonus stop: Front Street Taproom

Front Street only serves regional and local beers so you're able to try some local favorites all under one roof.

Stop 3: DCR Brewing Co.

One man's dream turned into a Downtown Fargo brewery, DCR Brewing serves a variety of ales, pilsners, and more.

Bonus stop: Proof Artisan Distillers

Try out some vodka, gin, or whiskey at Proof which have all been locally grown and produced.

Stop 4: Pixeled Brewing Co.

Brewery + arcade. Try some local brews and play on vintage machines like Ms. Pac Man, Frogger, Mario Bros., and more. **Bonus stop:** Wild Terra Cider North Dakota's only Urban Cidery locally sources the apples to make delicious ciders that can be enjoyed on their gorgeous patio or cozy interior.

Stop 5: Fargo Brewing Company

Fargo's first brewery produces favorites like the Fargo Woodchipper IPA alongside rotating seasonal options.

Stop 6: Drekker Brewing Company

Another regional favorite, Drekker Brewing is located in one of Fargo's oldest and most beautiful buildings and specializes in sours.

Stop 7: Icewind Brewing

Located just outside of West Fargo in Mapleton, ND, Icewind has a variety of IPAs, seltzers, and sours.

Bonus stop: Prairie Rose Meadery

This unique spot serves honey wine with a variety of flavors in a cozy tasting room.

Top 5 Places to See and Buy Local Art

1. Unglued Market Place: Unglued is gift shop that sells works from hundreds of local and regional artists and is my number one all time favorite place to find unique art, gifts, and things I never knew I needed. (You can find my art there as well)

2. Murals: Murals have been becoming a larger part of the FM community and I LOVE that. Just taking a stroll through downtown there are at least 6 that I can think of off the top of my head!

3. Art Events: Held in restaurants, warehouses, and office buildings, the events are themed or offer a fun evening out for the community and opportunity for local artists to showcase their work. The Art Syndicate and EPIC events are two that I personally have participated in in the last year.

4. Craft Fairs and Markets: The Mini Makers Market, Unglued Craft Fest Events, The Island Park Art Show, Folkways Night Bazaar and the West Fargo Street Fair are a few that I participated in. Also, Christkindlmarkt, Red River Market, and the Downtown Street Fair.

5. Museums: Plains Art Museum and the Rourke are always hosting local shows as well as curating shows with their collections of artwork. In addition to that, the colleges in town have art galleries as well showcasing student work and guest artist shows.

FMCT

We caught up with Judy from the FMCT to see what they're up to, here's what we found out

Tell us a little bit about FMCT

In 1946, a group of like-minded theatre enthusiasts recognized that theatre was a missing piece in the Fargo-Moorhead community and began organizing productions in neighborhood homes, churches, and auditoriums creating the Fargo Moorhead Community Theatre (FMCT).

FMCT's theatrical season hosts up to 12 stage and musical productions where volunteers from the community are the actors. Each year, productions offer up to 400 acting opportunities to area thespians and educational programming provides yearround opportunities for students of all ages.

FMCT is passionate about making theatre accessible to everyone through programming like FMCT ED On the Road, Sensory Friendly performances, rush ticketing, the community stage, and audio description and has grown to become an integral piece of the community for 75 years.

What lessons did you learn from the pandemic and how was FMCT able to get through it?

We learned how to pivot and to think outside of tradition. COVID forced all arts groups to think creatively about their work. As an organization we take very seriously the "community" in our name.

When the world shut down and children were sent home from school. Parents who

still had to go to work were lost so FMCT hired a certified teacher and developed day camps for students to work on their homework in the morning and play theatre games all afternoon.

We also grew quite a bit in our ability to utilize film in our theatre making. Our 75th anniversary performance of My Sister Eileen was completely digital and a lovely piece of theatre. We also produced a completely digital version of Dragons Love Tacos, and 168 Fargo classrooms purchased the video and study guide to show in their classes.

What are you looking forward to the most in 2022?

We're most looking forward to producing our inaugural season at the Hjemkomst Center. As we meet more and more people in Moorhead, we're seeing how excited the community is to have us in the iconic building.

The 2022 season begins on January 21 & 22 and 28 & 29 with our annual 10-Minute play festival which will showcase eight 10-minute plays written by people from all over the world.

Other performances:

Steel Magnolias goes up February 3-5 and 9-13

Elephant & Piggie performs for the public on February 26

A Few Good Men opens March 24 - 26 and March 30 - April3

9 to 5 runs from May 13 -14, 18 - 21, & 26 - 29

Summer 2022 will bring our educational musical and a chance to take a small troupe of actors to some towns in rural ND - we plan to bring a show to some towns that have no active theatres. It's our hope to mentor these communities to develop community theatre groups of their own.

In October, fans can look forward to a play written by Joseph Zettelmaier called *All Childish Things* that will bring out the Star Wars fan in all of us.



ART LOVER'S ITINERARY

Fargo is full of art, from murals on brick walls and wrapped benches and electrical boxes to North Dakota's largest art museum, there's no shortage of culture in this community.

>West Acres

Start out your time in Fargo with the artists at **Aptitude**, a 6,000 square foot arts incubator within the **West Acres Mall**. This "new way to shop for art" is located right off the



mall's common area and serves as a platform for the arts in the Fargo-Moorhead area.

>Museums

Explore Fargo's art museums and local galleries. No matter your taste, there's something for everyone at **Plains Art Museum, The Rourke Art Gallery + Museum**, and **The Hjemkomst Center**.



>Art Scavenger Hunt

Take a guided tour of the local art pieces in Downtown Fargo using the **Adventure Lab App**. Similar to **Geocaching**, use your phone to follow instructions on how to get to multiple locations. Once you get to the location, the app will ask you to answer a question about the piece and then you can move on to the next spot.

>Shopping Downtown

From there, head out to some of the local galleries throughout Downtown Fargo to purchase your own piece of local art. Check out spots like **Gallery 4**, **The Spirit Room**, or **Dakota**



Fine Art for some local art flair, or head to **Unglued** or **Zandbroz** for a variety of local wares created by makers in the community.

>Theatre

Finish your day immersed in the stage with Trollwood players, The Stage at Island Park, Theatre B, or Fargo-Moorhead Community Theatre. Looking for something else? Fargo also has an Opera, Ballet, Choral Artists group and a Symphony Orchestra.

Fargo is a city that never fails to entertain. Nightlife may look a little different for the time being, but the bars and live entertainment in the city have kept the good times rollin'. Looking for a lively and safe adventure? Fargo's got ya covered.

INT FIND YOUR CROWD

>Dancing

Learn to swing dance at a Fargo Swing Dancing event (find them on Facebook!). Arthur's Barn hosts good ol' fashioned barn dances, or boogie to live bands at The Windbreak, TAK Music Venue (open to all ages), or the Downtown VFW. Or check out The OB for a dance club night.

>Comedy & Open Mic

Your first stop for comedy should be **The Cellar**, Fargo's only dedicated comedy club, in the basement of **Front Street Taproom** (which hosts open mic music, poetry, and comedy every Monday).

Thursdays, you'll find open mic poetry at **Red Raven Espresso Parlor** (open to all ages) and open mic comedy and music at **Dempsey's** or **DCR Brewing**.

> Dives

Fargo's oldest bar, **Bismarck Tavern**, has Grain Belt on tap (enough said). Next door another oldie-but-goodie, **Empire Tavern**, makes notoriously stiff drinks. **Duffy's** – Fargo's original Irish bar – is a 50-year-old staple.

Outside Downtown, **Rick's Bar** and **Speck's Bar** always have live bands and locals playing pool. In West Fargo, you'll find the same at **M & J Saloon, Town Hall**, and the biker bar, **Silver Dollar**. For Moorhead's classic dives, head to **Mick's Office** and **JC Chumley's**.

>Sports Fans

TVs at every table and a buffet served on a classic car? Go to **Tailgators Sports Cafe**. For wall-to-wall HD screens and a peanut bar, check out **Wild Bill's Sports Saloon**. **Brewtus' Brickhouse** is a must for brickfired pizzas and game day specials. **Legends** offers free shuttle rides to NDSU tailgating, all-day happy hour on Sundays, and plenty of screens. **Sidestreet** has plenty of room to watch the game while you play pool. At **Sports Zone** the name says it all, really.

>Beer Drinkers

Fill an infamous "Das Boot" with one of **Wurst Bier Hall's** 41 beers, or drink brews made only in North Dakota, Minnesota, and South Dakota at **Front Street Taproom**.

Sidestreet pours from 50 taps, while **JL Beers** – voted "best beer drinking spot in North Dakota" – serves national and global pints. Don't forget Fargo's seven craft breweries (pg. 16).

Get Midwestern and order a light beer with a pickle or green olives in it.

>Cocktails

Some of the city's best cocktails are mixed during happy hour at **Mezzaluna**. Sip tasty martinis at the Rosewild or a fantastic mule on the rooftop at **Camp Lone Tree**.

A Moorhead favorite, **Harold's On Main**, pours tasty and original creations in their cozy, TV-less setting, while **Maxwell's** in West Fargo make what we can only call dang good cocktails in upscale settings.





One of the area's newest event plazas, **The Lights**, has come to West Fargo for community members and visitors alike to enjoy. Located on Sheyenne Street and 32nd Avenue in West Fargo, check it out for the events and things to do no matter what the season is.

>Event plaza

Concerts at the Essentia Health Plaza take place throughout the summer. Last year, acts like Kip Moore and Old Crow Medical Show took the stage as well as the Chutes n' Boots Bull Riding event. Plus, local musical talents also play at the plaza throughout the week.

If you're looking for something for the whole family, events like Kidchella and movie nights on the plaza are perfect for the kids as well as the splashpad that helps to cool them off throughout the summer.

Other outdoor events in the plaza include yoga on the lawn and picnics on the plaza where you can get active with other yogis or enjoy a lunch with your pals on the lawn. Plus, West Fargo Events hosts camp out family fun nights where the kids can learn camping basics like casting lessons, archery, and axe throwing while they enjoy some yummy s'mores.

>lce rink

From November through mid-March, the plaza is transformed into a beautiful iceskating rink complete with twinkly lights and fun events for the season. They host events like movie nights on ice, college hockey watch parties, and even curling events. Open skate and open hockey events happen throughout the entire season as well, and the rink even turns green for St. Patrick's Day!

> Other things to do at The Lights

Besides the Plaza, there are some great local businesses that you can enjoy if you're heading this way. **Bar Down** is a hockey-themed bar located right outside of the plaza and has great bar food, drinks, and daily specials. **Moxie Java** coffee is a local coffee shop located right within the Lights as well, they are perfect for a morning pick me up or a warm cocoa after you get off the rink.

If you're looking to do some shopping, Jade + Jasper boutique is a great, local boutique for women's clothing and accessories. Another dining experience within the space is Tati's Mediterranean Saveur which serves traditional Mediterranean meals and desserts.
