






Carol Miller serves as a Data Dissemination Specialist for the U.S. Census Bureau.

A Quick Look at QuickFacts



What Quick Facts Does

- Over sixty (60) data points at your fingertips
- Data for nation, state, county, and places with over 5000 population
- Able to share, print, map, embed, create charts and graphs.
- Uses multiple surveys for data updates
- Can stack up to six geographies

What QuickFacts Doesn't do

- Does not present data for populations under 5000
- Cannot be reproduced after updates are installed
- Different vintages are reported from different surveys
- Zip codes are translated into
 zip code tabulation areas –
 they are not always the same
- Estimates are not comparable to other geographies due to methodology differences
